
MISIÓN PARROQUIAL

He reminds Christians that the apostles themselves worked in "toil and drudgery" as a model for how we ought to contribute to our community. The Gospel returns to the apocalyptic tone of Malachi, describing the utter chaos of the end-times. We will know the end is near when violence, catastrophe, and hatred dominate the earth. But we must not fear! God's saving plan brings peace to our hearts. Malachi speaks of the sun's "healing rays," and Jesus himself promises to protect every hair on our heads.

Malaquías habla de los "rayos sanadores" del sol, y el mismo Jesús promete proteger cada cabello de nuestras cabezas.





Committee & Candidates I cannot say enough good things about our parish volunteers. God inspires us, and our volunteers propel us forward. As is often said, actions speak more eloquently than



Arise and Build ❖ Monthly Bulletin Announcement ❖ November 2019

As of October 31, 2019, the total amount in our Building Fund is \$5,527,780.25

As you have heard, a lot is happening on the construction front. Just last week Fr. James approved a \$10,000 down payment on the steel frame for the building and roof. We are no longer just paying for plans and studies, we are actually ordering construction materials!

We also announced last month that the public hearing for our project has been scheduled for the evening of December 18 at the Wildomar City Council Chambers! In preparation for that meeting, our 30 day public comment/review period commenced on October 22 and will close on November 20.

This open comment period is when any interested parties can comment and ask questions about our proposed project. Then, on the 18th of December, the City of Wildomar will formally review the project and respond to any questions. If all goes well, our building permit should be approved shortly thereafter. If you are interested in attending the hearing on December 18, and we hope there will a sizable delegation from St. Frances of Rome in attendance, please sign up after mass today at the information table in front of the church.

Isn't it incredible to think that the construction phase is now within our sight? Keep the faith, keep the prayers, and keep the contributions coming! Speaking of contributions, ***as of October 31, 2019, the total amount in our Building Fund is \$5,527,780.25. That is an increase of \$89,070.21 over our month end total in September!*** We are so close to our goal!

To end the year strong, last week, Fr. James distributed his year-end building fund appeal. Whether to complete your pledge, to go above and beyond your annual pledge, and/or to make a contribution for the first time, please prayerfully consider a year end contribution.

Let's get as close to 6 million in the bank as we can by the end of the year. Wouldn't that be awesome? Our permit approved and almost \$6 million in our building fund to start 2020! Of course all building fund donations are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Thank you for your faith and determination as we work together to build our new church.

Como has escuchado, están sucediendo muchas cosas referente a la construcción. La semana pasada, el Padre James aprobó un pago inicial de \$ 10,000 para compra de materiales de acero para el edificio y el techo. Ya no solo pagamos por planos y estudios, ¡en realidad estamos ordenando materiales de construcción!

¡También anunciamos el mes pasado que la audiencia pública para nuestro proyecto se programó para la noche del 18 de Diciembre en la Ciudad de Wildomar! En preparación para esa reunión, nuestro período de revisión / comentario público de 30 días comenzó el 22 de octubre y se cerrará el 20 de noviembre.

Este período de comentarios abiertos es cuando las partes interesadas pueden comentar y hacer preguntas sobre nuestro proyecto propuesto. Luego, el 18 de diciembre, la Ciudad de Wildomar revisará formalmente el proyecto y responderá a cualquier pregunta. Si todo va bien, nuestro permiso de construcción debe aprobarse poco después. Si está interesado en asistir a la audiencia el 18 de Diciembre, y esperamos que asista un grupo considerable de St. Francisca de Roma, regístrese hoy después de la misa en la mesa de información frente a la iglesia.

¿No es increíble pensar que la fase de construcción está ahora a nuestro alcance? ¡Mantengan la fe, mantengan las oraciones y sigan haciendo sus contribuciones! In just the second year of our capital campaign, we raised over \$3 million bringing our Building Fund to a staggering \$5.53 million as of Oct. 31, 2019. Yes, we are less than one million dollars away from raising the money required to fully pay for our new church. God is great! I'm totally humbled and very grateful to all the parishioners of St. Frances of Rome; for you have given your all to support this massive undertaking which 2 years ago, many thought was mission impossible!

In just a few weeks we celebrate Thanksgiving and begin the liturgical season of Advent. As this year comes to a close, we enter a period of joyful waiting not only for the birth of our Savior, but also for the construction of our new church. With great joy, I would like to share with you the good news that the city had tentatively scheduled a public hearing for the construction of our new church on Dec. 18, 2019. What does this mean? In essence, the city has approved our plan and with God's graces and blessings, we could actually break ground first quarter of 2020!

In this same spirit of hope and thanksgiving, I am asking you to please consider a special year-end gift of love to the Arise & Build Capital Campaign. All donations, regardless of the amount are gratefully accepted and equally appreciated. Moreover, your gift will be credited towards your pledge (if you made one) and is tax deductible to the extent allowable by law. We have come a long way this year in preparing the way for our new church. As we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ, I am reminded of the verse by Angelus Silesius:

Let us remain steadfast in our efforts to build our new church and our parish community upon a solid foundation of faith, hope, and love.

May the Spirit of the Christ Child remain in our hearts as we continue to embody the inspiration for our Arise & Build Campaign: "Rise, let us be on our way" (Mk 14:42).


