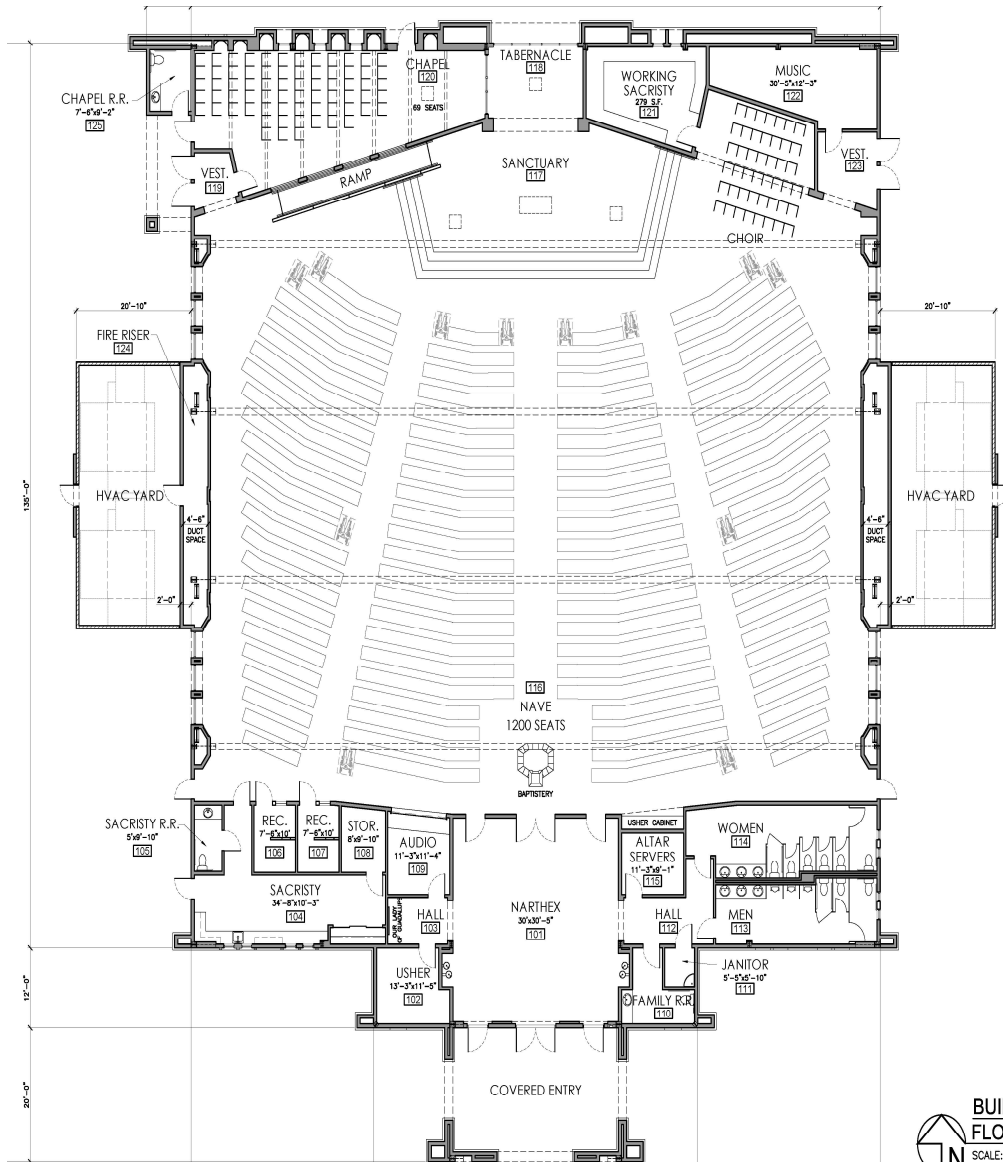

# Re: Coronavirus:

On February 28, 2020 Bishop Barnes released a statement regarding COVID-19, known as the coronavirus. The bishop has allowed certain practices that may be observed during the celebration of the liturgy of the Mass. The recommendations are as follows:

- ◆ The faithful should be encouraged to not hold hands during the reciting of the Our Father
- ◆ The faithful should be encouraged to share the Sign of Peace without touching hands or kissing. This can be done with meaningful eye contact, smiles, and a bow of the head in reverence to one another
- ◆ The precious blood is temporarily not to be shared with the faithful during Mass. Communion is only to be given in the species of the consecrated bread
- ◆ The faithful should be encouraged to receive communion in their hands, and not on their tongue
- ◆ Priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion should be especially reminded to wash their hands before Mass and after distributing communion

\*\*\*\*\*

- ◆ In addition, Fr James recommends to the faithful not to use the missalettes. Instead, we can listen to the word of God attentively as it is proclaimed
- ◆ The presiding priest may not shake hands with the faithful after Mass
- ◆ If you are sick you are not obligated to come to church

These simple recommendations are not given to hit our panic button. But they are prudent measures at this time to help minimize the spread of the virus.

El 28 de Febrero de 2020, el Obispo Barnes ha publicado una declaración sobre COVID-19, conocido como CORONAVIRUS. El Obispo ha permitido ciertas prácticas que pueden observarse durante la celebración de la liturgia de la Misa. Las recomendaciones son las siguientes:

- ◆ Sugiere a los fieles a no tomarse de la mano durante la recitación del Padre Nuestro
- ◆ Sugiere a los fieles a compartir el Signo de Paz sin tocarse ni besarse. Esto se puede hacer con contacto visual significativo, sonrisas y una inclinación de cabeza en reverencia entre sí
- ◆ La Sangre de Cristo no debe ser compartida temporalmente con los fieles durante la Misa. La comunión sólo debe darse en las especies del pan consagrado
- ◆ Se debe alentar a los fieles a recibir la comunión en sus manos, y no en su lengua
- ◆ Los sacerdotes, diáconos y ministros extraordinarios de la Santa Comunión deben recordarse que se laven las manos especialmente antes de la Misa y después de distribuir la comunión

\*\*\*\*\*

- ◆ Además, el P. James recomienda a los fieles que no usen los misales. En cambio, podemos escuchar la palabra de Dios atentamente mientras se proclama
- ◆ El sacerdote oficiante no puede estrechar la mano de los fieles después de la Misa
- ◆ Si usted está enfermo no está obligado a asistir a la iglesia

Estas sencillas recomendaciones no se dan para pulsar nuestro botón de pánico. Pero son medidas prudentes en este momento para ayudar a minimizar la propagación del virus.

# DIOCESE OF SAN BERNARDINO



## OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We continue to observe and respond to the worldwide health crisis of the coronavirus pandemic, and I take this opportunity to update you on our local diocesan actions as well as our calling as a people of faith in this time of distress.

As we hear news of the continuing spread of COVID-19, questions have come about the continuation of certain gatherings and events in our local Church. It is important to remember that in this moment we are called to prudence and safety, but also to be a presence of hope and spiritual sustenance amid the crisis. We must be careful to protect ourselves while also continuing to manifest Christ's love to our brother or sister in need.

In that spirit, we will continue to hold Masses in our parishes as scheduled. The celebration of the Eucharist is central and essential to our practice of faith and I feel it is my responsibility as the Chief Shepherd of this Diocese to continue to make this Sacrament available to the people. At the same time, I do recognize the anxiety that some may feel about entering large public gatherings, particularly those individuals who are of an age or health status that makes them more vulnerable to the virus. Therefore, I am granting a special dispensation to any and all of the Catholic faithful of the Diocese of San Bernardino from the weekly obligation to attend Mass until further notice.

Likewise, and in keeping with the directives of the San Bernardino and Riverside county departments of public health, I am asking our parishes and schools to suspend non-essential public gatherings of 250 or more people.

I encourage families to take the opportunity during this time of reduced gathering in our parish settings to strengthen and enhance faith practices at home. Reading the Gospels, praying the Rosary together and sharing faith perspectives on the events of the day are just a few ways we can continue to live our Catholic faith at home.

I want to extend my thanks to all our communities of faith for their cooperation with the liturgical guidelines put into place Feb. 28 by the Diocese that were designed to diminish physical contact between attendees at Mass and in the distribution of Holy Communion. Those restrictions will remain in place and the Diocesan Office of Worship will be providing additional instructions to shorten the duration of Mass.

Every day and throughout the day, we receive new information about the impacts of coronavirus. We see that the situation is changing rapidly, and the Diocese is staying informed and in communication with public health agencies so that any further actions that may be needed can be taken in a timely manner.

Let us continue to offer up to God our fears and concerns during this difficult time and let us remain in solidarity and mutual support of each other. We ask for the intercession of St. Bernardine and Our Lady of Guadalupe, patron and patroness of our Diocese, as we seek the healing presence of Jesus Christ in our communities and throughout the world.

Hermanas y Hermanos en Cristo,

Seguimos observando y respondiendo a la crisis global de salud frente la pandemia del coronavirus, y tomo esta oportunidad para darles una actualización sobre las acciones de nuestra Diócesis local y recordarles nuestro llamado como personas de fe en estos tiempos de angustia.

Mientras escuchamos las noticias sobre la continua difusión del COVID-19, han surgido preguntas sobre la continuación de ciertas reuniones y eventos de nuestra iglesia local. Es importante recordar que en este momento estamos llamados a la prudencia y a la seguridad, pero también a ser una presencia de esperanza y apoyo espiritual en medio de la crisis. Tenemos que tomar precauciones para cuidarnos mientras al mismo tiempo seguimos manifestando el amor de Cristo hacia nuestros hermanos y hermanas necesitados.

En ese espíritu, continuaremos ofreciendo Misas en nuestras parroquias de acuerdo con el horario actual. La celebración de la Eucaristía es central y esencial a nuestra práctica de fe y siento que es mi responsabilidad como Pastor Principal de nuestra Diócesis seguir ofreciendo este Sacramento a los fieles. Al mismo tiempo, reconozco que para algunos participar en grandes reuniones públicas puede causar ansiedad, particularmente para aquellos que sean mayores o tengan condiciones de salud que los haga más vulnerables al virus. Por lo tanto, estoy otorgando una dispensación especial a cualquier y todo fiel Católico de la Diócesis de San Bernardino de la obligación semanal de asistir a la Misa hasta próximo aviso.

Igualmente, y en línea con las directivas de los departamentos de salud pública de los condados de San Bernardino y Riverside, les estoy pidiendo a nuestras parroquias y escuelas que suspendan todas las reuniones no-esenciales de 250 personas o más.

Me gustaría animar a las familias a que tomen esta oportunidad en este tiempo en que tendremos menos reuniones en las parroquias que fomenten y fortalezcan las prácticas de fe en el hogar. Leer los Evangelios, rezar el Rosario juntos y compartir nuestras perspectivas de fe sobre los eventos del día son solamente algunas de las maneras en que podemos seguir viviendo nuestra fe Católica en el hogar.

Quiero extender mi sincero agradecimiento a las comunidades de fe por su cooperación con los lineamientos litúrgicos que fueron implementados el 28 de febrero por la Diócesis y cuya meta es disminuir el contacto físico entre los presentes en la Misa y en la distribución de la Santa Comunión. Estas restricciones permanecerán vigentes y la Oficina Diocesana de Culto Divino proveerá instrucciones adicionales para reducir la duración de la Misa.

Todos los días y a través del día recibimos nueva información sobre los impactos del coronavirus. Vemos que la situación está cambiando rápidamente, y la Diócesis se está manteniendo informada y en comunicación con las agencias de salud pública para que en el caso de que se necesiten tomar medidas adicionales se puedan tomar lo antes posible.

Sigamos ofreciéndole a Dios nuestros miedos y preocupaciones durante este tiempo difícil y permanezcamos en la solidaridad apoyándonos el uno al otro. Pedimos la intercesión de San Bernardino y Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, patrón y patrona de nuestra Diócesis, mientras buscamos la presencia sanadora de JesuCristo en nuestras comunidades y alrededor del mundo.

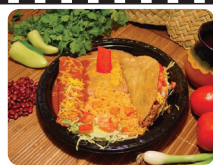

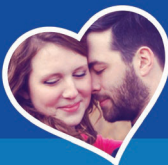

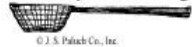
