ST. JOHN, Apostle and Evangelist

December 27 - Patron Saint of Asia Minor

St. John, the son of Zebedee, and the brother of St. James the Great, was called to be an Apostle by Our Lord in the first year of His public Mission. He became the “beloved disciple” and was the only one of the twelve who did not forsake the Savior in the hour of His Passion. He stood forth faithfully at the foot of the Cross, whence the dying Savior made him the guardian of His Immaculate Mother. His later life was passed chiefly in Jerusalem and at Ephesus. He founded many churches in Asia Minor. He wrote the fourth Gospel, three Epistles and the book of the Apocalypse. Brought to Rome, tradition relates that he was by order of the Emperor Domitian cast into a caldron of boiling oil but came forth unhurt and was banished to the island of Patmos for a year. He lived to an extreme old age, surviving all his fellow Apostles, and died at Ephesus about the year 100.

St. John is called the Apostle of Charity, a virtue he had leaned from his Divine Master, and which he constantly inculcated by word and example. The “beloved disciple” died at Ephesus where a stately church was erected over his tomb. It was afterwards converted into a Mohammedan mosque.




