

Please take note of the information listed below.

A friendly reminder about our collective responsibilities and expectations regarding owning this new Church:

- ◆ We all put in a lot of work and money to make this possible over many years so please be considerate and help take care of our new building.
- ◆ Please do not bring markers or colors to entertain your children during Mass. These markers and colors usually miss the paper and would end up staining the new light-colored pews and dry walls. Even the young ones can be taught to appreciate the Mass and learn to be respectful during the service. Never too early to teach our children.
- ◆ Please no sharp toys. These can scratch the wood on the new pews.
- ◆ Please do not use kneelers as foot rest or stand on them. In the old church we were on the ground. Let's understand that these kneelers will last if treated respectfully. They also have a hydraulic system, therefore standing or abusing the kneelers becomes a repair cost footed indirectly by all parishioners.
- ◆ There is no need to push the kneelers up or down with your foot because the hydraulics will take care of those movement
- ◆ Please no littering inside or outside the church
- ◆ Hopefully, we will all treat our new building and furnishings as if we had purchased them ourselves for our homes. Remember if you treat even a piece of furniture with respect we are helping take care of God's house



Un recordatorio amistoso sobre nuestras responsabilidades y expectativas con respecto a ser dueños de ésta nueva Iglesia:

- ◆ Todos hemos puesto mucho trabajo y dinero para hacer esto posible durante muchos años, así que por favor sea considerado y ayude a cuidar nuestro nuevo edificio.
- ◆ Por favor no traiga marcadores ni colores para entretener a sus hijos durante la Misa. Estos marcadores y colores generalmente pierden el papel o la tapa y terminarían manchando las nuevas bancas y, o las paredes , como vemos las bancas y las paredes son de colores claros. Incluso a los niños mas grandecitos se les puede enseñar a apreciar la Misa y a aprender a ser respetuosos durante el servicio. Nunca es demasiado temprano para enseñar a nuestros hijos.
- ◆ Por favor, no se permiten juguetes punzantes o filosos. Estos pueden rayar la madera de las bancas.
- ◆ Por favor, no utilice los reclinatorios como reposapiés ni se pare sobre ellos. En la antigua iglesia estábamos en el suelo. Entendamos que estos reclinatorios durarán si se tratan con el debido cuidado. También cuentan con un sistema hidráulico, por lo que pararse o abusar de los reclinatorios se convierte en un costo de reparación que corre indirectamente por todos los feligreses.
- ◆ No es necesario empujar los reclinatorios hacia arriba o hacia abajo con el pie porque el sistema hidráulico se encargará de esos movimientos.
