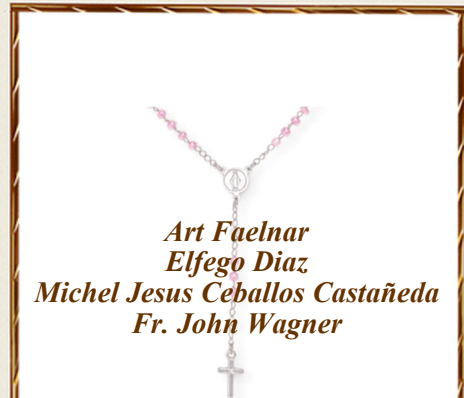

Every year we celebrate the glorious event of Easter—the resurrection of Christ from the dead. I hope this is more than just a noble routine year after year. This is a reality that begs for a deeper reflection and acceptance. Jesus Christ was the first to rise from the dead who did not eventually die. This reality is sometimes met with sea of doubts by non-Christians and Christians alike. But doubts do not make this fact less real. The resurrection proclaims that there is life after our physical death—a glorious and eternal life. Every soul has a need far deeper than food, drink and sexuality.
